## Printable Ring Size Guide

Print this guide on A4 paper at 100% scaling. Check your page has printed at the correct size by placing a credit card over the drawing.

#### MEASURING TIPS:


If you are between sizes, go for the larger size for a more comfortable fit.


A wider ring band will feel more snug, so we suggest sizing up in this case.

The size of your fingers changes naturally throughout the day and with heat. We recommend measuring when they are at their largest for the most comfortable fit, this will most likely be in the evening and when your hands are warm.

## Method 1 - Measure a ring you own

Place a ring you already own in the correct size over the sizing circles below. The circle should line up with the inside of the ring.





### Method 2 - Print your own ring sizer


Please note, this is only a guide - we find Method 1 easier and more accurate. You can also order a reusable (and very accurate) ring sizer on our website.

**STEP 1:** Cut out the ring sizer and cut a slit on the line marked at the top.

STEP 2: Push the end of the sizer through the slit and slide over your finger.

STEP 3: Adjust to fit, making sure it can slide on/off comfortably.

STEP 4: The letter that the arrow is pointing to is your ring size.



This line should measure 140mm
